1	<b>Arrival- Hanoi Airport</b> Arrival at Noi Bai Airport, you will be warmly welcomed and transferred to hotel by private driver with signboard, check in, relax. Overnight at hotel in Hanoi.	-
2	<b>Hanoi – Halong – Hanoi</b> Hotel Breakfast. Make an early departure from Hanoi and drive 3.5 hours through the Red River Delta on your way to Halong City. Arrive in Halong Bay at noon, board a traditional wooden junk and start the cruising trip to the Bay. Fresh seafood lunch is served while the boat is gliding out. Get ready for exotic photos and absorbing the most magnificent natural splendors limestone bedrocks and sheer cliffs of tiny islands highlighted with fanciful name: <b>Fighting Cocks</b> (symbol of Halong Bay), <b>Duck, Swan, Incense Burner, and Stone Dogs</b> . Visiting the most beautiful cave named <b>Thien Cung (Heaven Palace Grotto)</b> and explores huge chambers adorned with stalactites and stalagmites of all kinds. Continue to enjoy this relaxing cruise on the way back to Ha Long harbor after 4hours trip. Driver is waiting and takes you back to Hanoi city. Trip ends at your hotel around 1930-2000hrs.	B L
3	<b>Full day Hanoi City Tour</b> Breakfast at hotel. 0800-0830 Guide and driver will pick you up at hotel in Hanoi Old Quarter. Then visit <b>Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum and Museum</b> . Enjoy the architectural an historical aspects of Uncle Ho's final resting-place. Just next door is Ho Chi Minh's house on stilts. Lying to one side of the Mauseoleum is the One Pillar Pagoda ~ founded by king Ly Thai To in 1049 the structure has become an important symbol for the people of Hanoi. Continue to visit the quan thanh Temple (Taoist ~ dating from the Ly Dynasty) and Buddhist Tran Quoc Pagoda on West Lake (one of the oldest in Vietnam). After lunch proceed to visit the Ethnology Museum, continue to visit the Literature Temple and Quoc Tu Giam. Vietnam's first university constructed in 1070~it's gardeners and well-preserved architecture offers a relaxing glimpse into Vietnam's past. Tour will pass by Hoan Kiem Lake ~ see the peaceful waters~ and visit Ngoc Son Temple. For the end of the tour journey visit by coach trip along the Hanoi Old Quarter. Free time for shopping. Note: Monday & Friday morning: Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum and Ethnic Museums are closed - Bat trang Pottery village will be arranged as substitution. Saturday & Sunday; Enjoy the water puppet show in Museum of Ethnology and 1 hour visiting the Old Quarter by Cyclo.	B L
